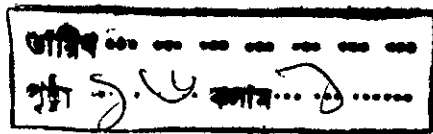

## **14 more JCD activists rehabilitated in DU hall**

Fourteen more JCD activists were rehabilitated in Surya Sen Hall of Dhaka University on Friday under the supervision of university authorities, reports UNB.

After long four years DU authorities started the rehabilitation of students belonging to Jatiaytabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) ousted by rivals from different dormitories.

Earlier, 67 JCD activists were rehabilitated in Surya Sen, Ziaur Rahman, Bangabandhu and Jashimuddin Hall on Thursday.

JCD enforced indefinite student strike in the university from July 29 demanding rehabilitation of their workers in the halls. The strike is likely to end today (Saturday).

The university authority has called a meeting of the Paribesh Parishad today (Saturday) in a bid to restore academic atmosphere in the university.

Representatives of all student organisations have been asked to attend the meeting.

Meanwhile, Dhaka University Provost-Standing Committee has strongly condemned and protested the withdrawal of security guards of the Vice-Chancellor and Proctor.

The committee at a meeting on Friday said the security guards were withdrawn without consultation with the university authority in a critical situation on the campus.

It demanded of the government to reappoint the security guards and arrest those who hurled abuse at the VC Prof AK Azad Chowdhury at Surya Sen Hall on Thursday.
