



DU Deans election likely on Dec 10

The election of the deans of eight faculties of the Dhaka University is likely to be held on December 10, 2001.

The decision was taken at an informal meeting of the stalwarts of BNP and Jamaat-backed White Panel on Saturday.

There would be a little change in the candidate-list of White Panel. Prof Asaduzzaman of Public Administration is the only candidate for the deanship of Social Sciences Faculty. Prof Iftikhar-ul-Awal of History, a new face in dean election, is the principal contender of White Panel for the deanship of Arts Faculty.

Prof Abul Kalam Azad will be the candidate of White panel for the deanship of Business Studies Faculty. The other probable candidate from White panel are Prof Ershadul Bari for Law faculty, Prof Chowdhury Mahmud Hasan for Pharmacy Faculty, Prof AFM Yousuf Haider for Science faculty and Prof Abul Basher for Biological Science faculty.

The opposition Awami League-backed Blue Panel is yet to finalise their list of candidate. A senior member of Blue Panel said they would announce their candidate-list after the official announcement of election schedule.

DU students who fail to stay in halls may contact Proctor office

Dhaka University authorities have asked the students who cannot stay in their respective halls to contact the university Proctor office, reports UNB.

The authorities' instruction came on Saturday as recent untoward incidents on the campus forced a section of students to leave their halls.

"The university authorities are determined to ensure security of resident students and rehabilitate them in their own dormitories," they said in a statement on Saturday.

"Those who are unable to contact physically they can contact the Proctor office through mail."
