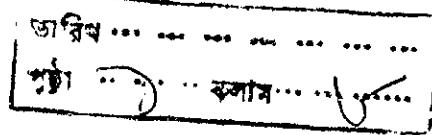

DU authorities to hold talks with student bodies

Dhaka University authorities are going to hold series of dialogues with the student-bodies active on the campus to ensure 'peaceful coexistence'.

As part of the new administration's initiative, the authorities will sit with opposition Awami League's student wing Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) today (Monday).

After a long correspondence BCL president Bahadur Bepari on Saturday agreed to sit with the authorities, sources at BCL said. The BCL president put forward a long list of demands.

Meanwhile, the ultimatum given by the authorities to the outsiders still staying in the dormitories to leave the dormitories ended on Sunday.

The authorities earlier said if necessary continuous raid would

be conducted in the DU dormitories to oust the outsiders.

With the untoward incidents of November 13 following the new vice chancellor's assumption of office the authorities formed a seven-member probe body and vowed to expel the offenders from the university. The committee was given a seven day time which is to end on November 21 to submit the reports.
