

IU academic activities disrupted

ISLAMIC UNIVERSITY, Oct 21.—The administrative and academic activities in the Islami University is being hampered as Zia Parishad and pro-BNP teachers imposed restriction unofficial on Vice-Chancellor's work.

The members of Zia Parishad has given an ultimatum to the Vice-Chancellor to resign from his post within October 30.

A tense situation has been prevailing on the campus following the statement and counter statement issued by the two groups of the parishad. The pressure put by the teachers representatives of the Zia Parishad on the VC to leave the campus by resigning has turned the situation more tense.

The IU VC told the Observer that he was yet to receive any notice or anything like that till Saturday. He also said that he would resign if the Chancellor of the university, teachers and students dislike him as the IU VC.
