## KU won't reopen before Feb 14 Convocation

KHULNA, Jan 29.—Despite yesterday's meeting of citizen bodies and political parties led by Khulna City Mayor held with Khulna University authority, the KU won't reopen before its Convocation to be held on February 14 next, said a reliable source.

Meanwhile, the KU authority has decided not to take any action against the primarily identified 27 guilty students before the submission of Probe Body Report, sources added.

In a press release of KU issued today highlighting yesterday's marathon meeting said. Every body in the meeting agreed to hold the Convocation properly and condemned the unruly behaviour of students on January 21 last that led the KU authority to close it sine die. The meeting also decided to take action against the guilty students after the submission of Probe Body Report. Senior citizens of Khulna also cancelled the responsibilities of communicating everybody which was assigned on KU Treasurer and Students Affairs Director today, Press release said.

KU Vice Chancellor Dr. S.M. Nazrul Islam told the Bangladesh Observer today that the preparation for holding by the Convocation was going on in fullswing.

The VC observed that it would not be possible to reopen KU before the Convocation.
