Move to reopen Khulna varsity

KHULNA, Jan 28.—Leaders of different political parties and citizens bodies at a meeting with Khulna University authority today have agreed to reopen KU very soon and soon and to hold upcoming second convocation of KU properly.

The meeting was held at KU conference room this afternoon with Mayor of Khulna City Corporation, Advocate Sheik Taiebur Rahman in the chair. Vice-Chancellor of KU Professor Dr S M Nazrul Islam represented KU authority in the meeting.

The meeting unanimously agreed to the reopening of KU very soon and holding of KU convocation with the Chancellor President Shahabuddin Ahmed.

It also observed that guilty students should seek unconditional apology to teachers they assaulted and promised not to repeat such incident in future. The meeting also called upon the teachers to pardon guilty students if they seek apology.
