2243 HSC examinees expelled on 4th day

A total of 2243 examinees were expelled on the fourth day of the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examinations on Monday on charge of copying.

Of the expelled examinees, 1053 are from Dhaka Board, 130 from Rajshahi Board, 130 from Jessore Board, 381 from Comilla Board, 187 from Chittagong Board, 125 from Sylhet Board and 125 from Barisal Board.

Two teachers were also expelled from a centre in Chapainawabganj district under Rajshahi Board for assisting examinees in copying.

No violent incident was reported from anywhere in the country during the Monday Bengali 2nd paper examinations.

Our Rajshahi Correspondent reports: The highest 1053 examinees were expelled from the board on the fourth day of the HSC examinations on Monday.

The district wise break-up of the expelled students are: 1053 in Rajshahi, 22 in Chapainawabganj, 22 in Natore, 43 in Pabna, 66 in Sirajganj, 26 in Naogaon, 110 in Joypurhat, 19 in Joypurhat, 56 in Lphamari, 31 in Lalmonirhat, 2 in Dinajpur, 182 in Thakurgaon, 138 in Sirajganj and 54 in Sirigram.
