



RU classes resume despite strike call

RAJSHAHI UNIVERSITY, Mar 24.—Classes of all the departments of Rajshahi University resumed today (Saturday) refuting two days strike (March 24-25) called by Rajshahi District Unit of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) and Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS).

The District Unit of JCD and ICS leaders gave the strike call from a gathering at Shaheb Bazar on Friday evening.
