



Ctg Board official attacked by miscreants

CHITTAGONG, May 13:—One senior official of Chittagong Education Board (CEB) was seriously injured when miscreants attacked the transport of a vigilance team of the board at Nazirhat here on the third day of the ongoing HSC examination today, reports BSS.

Miscreants halted the vehicle carrying Deputy Controller Obaidul Akbar and four others in front of Nazirhat Janker Cinema Hall and pelted stones on the vehicles indiscriminately, Chairman of CEB Prof. Ahmed Hossain said.

Obaidul Akbar was seriously injured when stones hit on his head after pierced the glass of the microbus, the sources said.

He was immediately taken to Hathazari Health Complex in a critical condition.

Being annoyed by stern anti-copying measures of the board a group of students of Nazirhat college might have happened the occurrence, the CEB Chairman said.

The CEB authority has relieved an acting principal and secretary of the Boalkhali Serajul Islam Degree College centre Abu Tayeb Chowdhury from his duty for his demeour with the vigilance team of the board yesterday, the sources said.

Meanwhile, a total of 625 students were expelled for adopting unfair means from different centres on today's Bengali first paper exam.
