## Syndicate poll Blue Panel wins while White Panel gets 5

The Awami League Blue Panel won eight posts while BNP and its supported White Panel got five posts in the elections to elect their Representatives in the Syndicate, Academic Council and Finance Committee of Dhaka University held on Thursday. The Blue Panel captured five of six posts in the Academic Council. The White Panel bagged the remaining one post. The Blue Panel also secured the lone post of Finance Committee.

On the contrary, the White Panel grabbed four out of six posts in the Syndicate, the second highest executive body of the university. The Blue Panel secured the rest two posts of the Syndicate.

The left-leaning Pink Panel, the third contender in the race, failed to capture any position in the elections to three vital bodies of the university.

The elected members in the Academic Council from the Blue Panel are Dr AFM Abdul Moyeen (47), Dr M Akhteruzzaman (50), Dr M Abdul Malek (469), Mohammad Abdus Samad (49) and ASM Maksud Kamal (46). Tahmina Akhter (468) secured the other post from the White Panel.

In the Finance Committee, Dr M Mahfuzur Rahman won by 8-406 margin against Dr Anwar Hossain of the White Panel.

The four members of the Syndicate elected from the White Panel are M Hasanuzzaman (557), Dr AFM Yusuf Haider (540), M Mohammad Ali (498) and Dr Mohammad Asaduzzaman (480). The
