ADMISSION (Session 2001-2002)

Applications are invited for admission to the BBA Program at IBA.

WHO CAN APPLY

(a) Anyone with a Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) or its equivalent in any subject group, with minimum 5 (five) qualifying points calculated on the following basis:

Certificate	1st Division	2nd Division
SSC or equivalent	3 points	2 points
HSC or equivalent	3 points	2 points

(b) Anyone who has passed at least five subjects (including Mathematics) in GCE O' Level and at least two subjects in GCE A' Level, provided s/he has minimum 5 (five) qualifying points, as per the following table. The Grade Point Average (GPA) is calculated by converting letter grades to numbers (A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1) and averaging the best five O' Level grades and best two A' Level grades.

	GPA \geq 3.0	1.5 \leq GPA $<$ 3.0
GCE O' Level	3 points	2 points
	GPA \geq 2.5	1.5 \leq GPA $<$ 2.5
GCE A' Level	3 points	2 points

(c) For all other foreign certificates, equivalence will be determined by IBA.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

- 1) Admission Test: All eligible candidates are required to sit for IBA's Admission Test, except those who have obtained a score of 1200 or more (with at least 400 in Verbal) in SAT-1.
- 2) Interview: Candidates will be called for an interview on the basis of their performance in the Admission Test (or SAT-1).
- 3) Selection: Final selection for admission will be based on marks obtained in the Admission Test (or SAT-1) and the interview.

HOW TO APPLY

- 1) Collect the Application Pack from Agrani Bank, Curzon Hall Branch, Dhaka University, on payment of Tk.300/- (non-refundable) from **November 4, 2001 onwards**. Alternatively, you may request the BBA Program Office for an Application Pack via mail by sending a Bank Draft for Tk.300/- drawn in favour of "BBA Admission, IBA", along with a self-addressed envelope (size 10" x 8") affixed with Tk. 35/- postage stamp.
- 2) Submit the completed application form to the BBA Program Office during office hours on weekdays, starting from November 4, 2001. **The last date for receiving admission forms will be Monday, November 26, 2001.** The Admission Test will be held at 10 a.m. on **Friday, November 30, 2001.**
