Science And Tech & Development In B

In the present age of technological development and the global economy, there is no more room for complacency. Knowledge and resource and more specifically the efficient management of the two has become the requirement for sustainable development. At the outset, it must be clearly known as to what is meant by the term development which does not necessarily consist of accumulation of wealth and the greater availability of goods and services only, but also upliftment of the social, cultural and spiritual dimensions of the human being. The dramatic and unprecedented revolution in science and technology, which is still accelerating, has been involved directly or indirectly with all aspects of growth and development activities in such a way that we cannot imagine life without the same. Food, clothes, health, education, housing, communication, exchange of ideas, protection of environment etc., depend on the study and the efficient use of science and technology. Development of all sectors of economy as mentioned above is, on the other hand, closely linked with the reliable and adequate supply of energy at a desired time. The present paper is an endeavor to discuss the role of nuclear science and technology on some important sectors of national economy and also to address some of the impediments to progress of science and technology and suggest possible remedies to them.

The present unethical practice of using DDT for the preservation of dry fish should be stopped by all means, and gamma ray be used in its place.
