## Teachers urged to work for infusing modern ideas in edn

President Professor AQM Badruddoza Chowdhury on Saturday said the teachers should have progressive outlook and come forward for developing the country's educational environment, reports UNB.

Stressing on qualitative education incorporating computer and information technology he said that the teachers should work for infusing modern ideas in education and developing the standard of teaching.
