

Khaleda slates incident of setting fire to Feni school

Leader of the Opposition in Parliament and BNP Chairperson Begum Khaleda Zia on Sunday condemned the incident of setting fire to a school in Feni.

In a statement, she said that "terrorists of the ruling party had set fire to a school under the leadership of the ruling party MP". She said that "this godfather had established a reign of terror in Feni".

She said that terrorists under the leadership of the godfather were carrying out killings, extortion and atrocities.
