

HC stays appointment process of 573 RU employees

The High Court (HC) Monday stayed appointment process of 573 third and fourth grade employees of Rajshahi University until October 15, reports 1 News.

A HC vacation bench comprising Justice Nazrul Islam and Justice Siddique Raaman Monday passed the order upon hearing public interest litigation (PIL) filed by Fazle Hossain Bader, former Vice President (VP) of Central Student Union challenging the advertisement for appointment in those posts.

The HC also issued a rule up the authority concerned including the RU administration to explain why the appointment process shall not be declared illegal.

In the PIL application it stated that RU authorities published 11 advertisements from May 24 to August 1 of this year for appointment of 573 employees.

According to University Service Rules, 60 percent post should be filled up internally, 10 percent from among the children of de-
