

## Teachers to observe token hunger strike tomorrow

Teachers of non-government hijools, colleges and madrasas will observe token hunger strike in they tomorrow protesting a circular depositing tuition fees to government fund against receiving 100 percent basic salary from government exchequer.

Teachers under the banner National Front of Teachers and Employees (NFT) will begin token hunger strike at Muktangon 10:00am forcing the caretaker government led by President's chief Adviser Iajuddin Ahmed to withdraw the condition.

According to the new circular issued by the education ministry on October 31, teachers of non-government institutes will get certain basic salary from the government exchequer but they will have to deposit tuition fees collected from students to the government fund.

Prof Quazi Farrique, chief coordinator and convener of NFTI said the president/ chief adviser should handover the responsibility of education ministry to any other person for solving various problems.
