Teachers' strike across country asses off 7th da

Teachers' strike across country passed off seventh day yesterday when their leaders failed to sit with the government without a formal announcement, UNB.

FEUF convenor Selim Bhuiyan said that the government formally asked them to sit for discussion. "But we won't sit with government without having formal announcement."

Teachers of non-government schools, colleges and madrasahs on indefinite strike jeopardise the academic career of thousands of students. They demand parity and fringe benefits as offered by the government teachers.

Striking teachers formed a human chain from zero point less Club in the city at 11 am yesterday for one hour. They organised similar programme in district upazila headquarters. Selim said they would hold a Muktangan on July 16 and meet government leaders.

NFTE, a separate organization of teachers, said they have received any response from the government to their demand.
