Primary schools facing accommodation crisis

MAGURA, Apr.20.— A total of 259 government and non-government primary schools in Magura district has been lacking in accommodation crisis, shortage of furniture, educational appliances as well as adequate number of teachers. In four Upazilas of Magura district a good number of schools has been in disarray due to the

said problems.

Students of the aforesaid area without sufficient sitting facilities are to sit either on bricks or mats.

As many as 75 thousand students of the schools have not yet received required number of books distributed free of cost under the universal prim-

ary education.

Repairing of schools is also being ignored. Many school houses damaged by cyclone and other natural calamities are left unrepaired pure drinking water and good latrine system are also another problem. A good number of the tubewells are un-repaired for a long time.
