

Govt to undertake mass literacy programme

MUNSHIGANJ, Apr. 20:— Minister for Education and Cultural Affairs Prof. A.Q.M. Badruddoza Choudhury today said, BNP government would undertake a massive programme for ensuring happiness and comfort for the people, reports BSS.

He said, it would take time to eliminate multifarious problems created by the autocratic government during last nine years.

The Minister was addressing a meeting held here to accord him reception at Rushdi High School premises under Srinagar Upazila of Munshiganj district.

Presided over by Mr. M. Shahjahan Bepari, the meeting was addressed by local Upazila chairman Kazi Azizul Hoq and BNP central leader, Mr. Shamsul Arefin Khan.

The Minister said "we face a food deficit of 15 lakh tons every year which can be avoided easily through change of food habit".

BNP Government would undertake a mass literacy and education programme for creating awareness about health, nutrition and basic rights among the people, he added.
