

Indefinite student strike begins at Khulna BIT

KHULNA, July 7:—An indefinite student strike began at the Bangladesh Institute of Technology (BIT) here today (Wednesday), reports UNB.

On Tuesday, the All-Party Student Unity called the strike protesting "misappropriation" of Tk 2 lakh of the BIT students union and demanding immediate holding of the silver jubilee of the Institute.

After twice shifting the date to July 8 and 15, the BIT teachers informed the students that it would not be possible to hold the silver jubilee function for want of money.
