

Call to hold DUCSU polls within 10 days

Leaders of Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU) in a rally on Sunday called upon the University authorities to announce the fresh date for holding DUCSU election and 14 residential hall unions within the next 10 days.

Held at the foot of Aparajeo Bangla, the rally was presided over by DUCSU G.S. and Joint Convener of JCD Khairul Kabir Khokan. It was addressed among others by AGS Nazimuddin Alam, JCD leaders Fazlul Haq Milon, Elias Ali and Moniruzzaman Monir.

The DUCSU leaders said the term of the present DUCSU was over on June 6 last and the law and order situation on the campus is in favour for holding a peaceful election. They alleged that some student fronts were trying to postpone the polls by creating violence on the campus. They also called upon the democratic student fronts to maintain peaceful atmosphere on the campus so that

The DUCSU leaders demanded arrest and trial of those responsible for the killing of Dr. Milon and a university student Mahabub who was killed on June 20 last on the campus.

Earlier they brought out a procession on the campus.
