Call to meet Govt College teachers demand by June 30

BCS General Education Association on Saturday warned that Government College teachers would launch their strike programme postponed earlier if their 16-point demand is not fulfilled by June 30, reports UNB.

President Dr. Habibur Rahman and Secretary General M. Abu Yusuf of the Association in a statement urged the Government to implement their demands, including the proposals made in the meeting held on March 29 with Education Minister in the chair, within the deadline.

If the Government fails to materialise the decisions on departmental promotions, including 20 per cent reserve posts, removal of anomalies in seniority and promotion, awarding higher scales as admissible, the teachers would be compelled to go for work-stoppage.

The leaders regretted although there had been decision to fill a post when it falls vacant, it was not being implemented because of dilly-dally. "The teachers are being deprived of due scales which are admissible in the posts equivalent to other cadres. The authorities many a time took decisions in the past, but did not materialise", the statement said.
