Govt college teachers to go on strike

Teachers of country's Government colleges threatened to go on work abstention for indefinite period if their 8-point demand was not met by December 8.

President of BCS General Education Association Dr. Q.A.T.M. Habibur Rahman and Secretary General Md. Abu Yusuf in a joint statement said that many a time the association had postponed its work abstention programme in response to the Government's assurance regarding fulfilment of the demands. But no effective step was taken by the respective authorities till today, they added.

The demands of the association include creation of new posts in Government colleges, providing higher scale to Lecturers after completion of four years service, and appointment of lecturers to the vacant posts.
