## 50,000 fake certificates of SSC, HSC, Master's Degree recovered

CHITTAGONG, July 1.—Police in a drive arrested the leader of an organised criminal gang and recovered a huge quantity of fake certificates and rubber stamps from a colony in the city on Sunday night, reports UNB.

Police following confessional statements of Dudul Sarker and Ashim Chakrabarty, who were arrested earlier on the day, nabbed Dayal Barua from Codak Press at Siraj-ud-Dowla Road.

Later, police in another drive at Joynab Colony of Dewan Bazar area recovered more than 50,000 fake certificates from the house of Jabi Ullah. He fled the house sensing the raid.

The recovered documents included HSC and SSC certificates, marksheets and testimonials of different colleges and schools under Comilla Education Board, and Master's Degree and Bachelor Degree certificates of Chittagong University and National University.

Police said the gang was involved in this criminal activities for a pretty long time and earned a huge amount of money by selling the fake documents.

They arrested persons confessed to the police that they used to sell fake documents at a cost of Tk 10,000 to Tk 50,000 each.
