

HSC examinees assault magistrate

KISHOREGANJ, July 23.—A magistrate and an assistant commissioner were allegedly assaulted by HSC examinees during massive violence at Karimganj College centre today, reports UNB.

The unruly students roughed up magistrate Hamidur Rahman Khan and Assistant Commissioner (land) Shafiqul Islam when they challenged an examinee involved in copying.

More than a dozen people, including policemen, were also injured in the incident that happened during Psychology 1st paper examination at the college centre.

Police said the examinees went on rampage stoning the principal's office where the magistrate and the AC (land) had to rain confined about 40 minutes.

When police tried to control the situation, the examinees also attacked them leaving four wounded. Nine students also received minor injuries.

The injured policemen are SI Anwar Hossain, ASI Benazir Ahmed and constables Abdul-Aziz and Babul Mia. Aziz was admitted to Karimganj thana hospital.

The agitating students set ablaze a jeep of district education office.

Police reinforcements from the district headquarters were called in to rescue the magistrate and the AC.

The examination could not be held due to the massive violence.
