

Workshop on exam system held

A day-long workshop on examination system of Bangladesh and its reform was held at National Academy for Educational Management (NAEM) auditorium on Monday, reports BSS.

Adviser in charge of the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports and Cultural Affairs Prof Md Shamsul Huq formally inaugurated the workshop. The inaugural session was also addressed, among others, by Additional Secretary of Education Ministry Muhammad Shahidul Alam and Director General of NAEM Prof. Md. Khurshid Alam.

The keynote paper was presented by Alauddin Ahmad, Deputy Director of NAEM. The workshop was participated by Education Board Chairman, teachers of different educational institutions and leaders of teachers associations.

Addressing the workshop, Education Adviser said government already initiated number of programmes to reform the whole education system. He said good examination system depends on good syllabus and good teaching.

Professor Huq suggested the teachers community to realise the attitudes of students and motivate them to accept the changed educational curriculum. If we follow the present syllabus and curriculum or education system will be raised upto international standard, he added.

Education Adviser said all zonal and district education office should have to enhance their supervision and monitoring activities to ensure quality education. He suggested the participants to produce effective recommendation from this workshop which will be helpful for the Ministry to adopt examination reform system.
