

# Canal digging in Feni, Chuadanga

FENI, Dec. 11.—The third phase of canal digging has been started in Feni Subdivision with a view to augmenting food production by providing increased irrigation facilities.

Mr. S. A. Z. M. Akramuzzaman, Subdivisional Officer, Feni, formally inaugurated the canal digging programme in presence of a huge gathering.

In all, 17 schemes have been taken up in the subdivision to be completed on voluntary basis.

The S.D.O. urged upon the people to engage themselves whole heartedly for successful implementation of the schemes. He also said that hundreds of acres of land would be benefited if the schemes were executed.

The thana wise break-up of the schemes is as follows: Feul Chhagalnaiya—5, Parshuram—3 and Sonagazi—4.

A Correspondent from Chuadanga adds: The re-excavation work of two and a half-mile long Trimohini canal, a link canal of Kadipur-Moranadi under Houli Union of Damurhuda Thana of this Subdivision, was formally inaugurated by Mr. Abdul Mannan Bhuiyan, Deputy Commissioner, Kushtia recently. A large number of people from all walks of life took part in the inaugural ceremony. When completed the re-excavation of the canal would provide irrigation facilities to over 300 acres of land.

In his inaugural speech the Deputy Commissioner called upon the people to take part in the canal digging programme to make the programme successful for attaining the target of food production as fixed by the Government.
