Plea to check book piracy

On the concluding day of the English Language Resources Fair held at the British Council on Saturday, one of the topics for debate was to bring awareness amongst the public against Book Piracy, says a Press release.

This programme was introduced by B.K. Saha, Information Service Manager and presided by Mr Justice Fazlul Karim of Bangladesh Supreme Court. Ms S Siraj, Advocate Supreme Court of Bangladesh delivered her presentation on the decline of educational values due to book piracy. She stressed on the bill passed by the parliament this year, which could make exemplary punishment to those involved with this trade.
