

# DU Hons exams postponed

The remaining portion of the Honours and Preliminary Masters Degree Examinations of 1983 in the traditional system of the Dhaka University in all centres in Dhaka and outside Dhaka has been postponed.

The new time-table of the examinations will be announced soon. All other examinations will be held according to the time-table announced earlier.

This decision was taken in an emergency meeting held at the Vice-Chancellor's office on Tuesday.

## Students demand exam continuation

Majority students appearing at the honours examination from five colleges of the city on Tuesday demanded continuation of honours examination at the Dhaka University centre. The students in a signed statement said that the honours examinees have already lost one academic year.

It may be mentioned here that honours examination at Dhaka University centre was suspended following violence and reign of terror created by some so

called students during the examination on October 25 and October 29.

The students condemned the university authority for suspending the examination at arts faculty only while continuing the examination outside Dhaka.

They urged the university authority to make arrangement for holding the rest of the examination on schedule. The students (See page 12 col. 1)

called upon all including the Government to punish the persons responsible for terrorism and creating terror and bring back the normal atmosphere on the campus. They said that the decision either to suspend or holding the examination of honours examination of the city colleges and outside the city should be simultaneous.

About one hundred students appearing at Honours examination from Jagannath College, Dhaka College, Titumir College, Eden College and Badrunnessa College were the signatories to the statement. Earlier in the morning the students came to the Jatiya Press Club on Tuesday and demonstrated their will for continuing the Honours examination at the Dhaka University centre.
