# 1226 more SSC examinees expelled

At least 1226 candidates and 24 invigilators were expelled on the fourth day of the Secondary School Certificate examinations yesterday, (Tuesday) according to reports from districts and four Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board till last midnight.

The highest numbers of candidates were expelled from the Dhaka Board 460 followed by Rajshahi Board 264.

A total of 246 examinees were expelled in Comilla Board while 18 candidates were expelled in Jessore Board.

The candidates were expelled for adopting unfair means while teachers for their negligence of their duties and for

supplying copies to the examinees.
