## 3137 HSC examinees expelled on 2nd day

A total of 3,137 candidates were expelled from 181 centres of four education boards on the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) Examination on Sunday on the third day of the examination, according to Boards officials, reports BSS.

Eight outsiders were also arrested in connection with the examination.

A Dhaka Board official said 1,288 candidates were expelled on Sunday from 90 centres of the Board for adopting unfair means in the examination. Two outsiders were arrested from the Jhenaigati Centre for supplying copies to the examinees, the official said.

A total of 941 examinees were expelled on Sunday from 24 centres of Comilla Board, a board official told BSS over telephone. Highest 191 candidates were expelled from Daudkandi Centre, the official said, adding that one teacher was also expelled on Sunday from Homna Centre for helping adopt unfair means in the examination. Six outsiders were also arrested one each from Devidwar, Nangalkot and four from Comilla—four centres of Comilla.

A Rajshahi Board official told BSS

over telephone that a total of 633 candidates were expelled on Sunday from 36 centres under the Board, while a Jessore Board official confirmed 275 expulsion from 31 centres of the Board.
