

3641 SSC examinees expelled on 2nd day

A total of 3,641 students and 18 invigilators were expelled and 27 outsiders arrested on the second day on Saturday of the Secondary School Certificate (SSC) Examinations, according to reports received in Dhaka, reports BSS.

One thousand one hundred ninety-four students were expelled from Dhaka Board, 1,738 from Rajshahi Board, 608 from Comilla Board and 101 from Jessore Board for adopting unfairmeans in the examinations.

Eighteen invigilators were expelled for supplying copies to the examinees. Of them, one was expelled from Narsingdi, five from Faridpur, one from Gopalpur, five from Jamalpur and six from Rajshahi.

Twenty-seven outsiders were arrested from different centres for supplying copies to the examinees. Among them, two were arrested from Madaripur, two from Narayanganj and 23 from Comilla. The highest 17 were arrested from Chandina

centre of Comilla alone.

Examinations of General English, both First and Second papers, were held on Saturday. Besides some minor incidents, the examinations were held peacefully.

Staff Correspondent adds:- A total of 1194 SSC examinees were expelled from different centres of the Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, Dhaka on the second day of the SSC examinations on Saturday. Examinations of English first and second papers were held on the day.

Earlier on Thursday during the examination of Bangla First and Second papers 1572 SSC Examinees were expelled from different examination centres under the Board for adopting unfairmeans in the examinations.

Twelve invigilators were also expelled from different centres for negligence of duty and supplying copies to the examinees.

The break-up of the examinees expelled is as follows:- Tangail- 207, Faridpur- 124, Madaripur-93, Shariatpur- 39, Narshingdi- 55, Munshiganj- 45, Rajbari- 22, Gopalganj-93, Jamalpur 239 and Sherpur 159.

Out of 12 invigilators expelled on the day included five from Faridpur, five from Jamalpur, one from Gopalganj and one from Narshingdi.

A total of 730 SSC examinees were expelled from 44 centres of the Board on Saturday. The total number of centres under the Board is 128. Three invigilators were also expelled from Chandina centre for negligence of duty.

Sec 144 violated

According to a source of Comilla Board, police fired several rounds of gunshots on Saturday to disperse the crowd who violated the Section 144 imposed around the Rauzan Centre in Chittagong district. The Chairman
