Six policemen injured in violence

3,911 SSC examinees expelled on first day

A total of 3,911 students and eight invigilators were expelled on the first day of the Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examinations on Thursday, according to reports received from four Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Boards, in Dhaka on Thursday nights, says BSS.

The students were expelled for adopting unfair means while the invigilators expelled for supplying copies to the examinees.

The examination was held peacefully excepting some minor incidents at Barura, Laksam and Hathazari centres under Comilla Board where six police personnel were injured. Eleven persons were taken into custody from Chandina centre for supplying copies.

Control Room at Dhaka Board told BSS that 1,472 from 82 centres were expelled for adopting unfair means in the examination. The highest number of students expelled from Pakundia centre under Kishoreganj was 193.

Besides, eight invigilators were expelled-four from Bhanga under Faridpur, two from Kishoreganj and two from Gopalganj centres.

In Jessore Board, 38 examinees were expelled from eight centres of the board. No untoward incident was reported from any centre of the board, according to control room of the Board.

According to information received from 79 centres out of 131 under Rajshahi Board 1671 candidates were expelled for adopting unfair means in the examination halls, official sources said.

Highest number of 617 candidates were expelled from 10 centres in Bogra district followed by 153 in Thakurgaon and 106 in Sirajganj.

When contacted over telephone Controller of Examinations of Comilla Board told BSS that 760 candidates were expelled, according to information received from 59 centres out of a total of 128 centres.

He said that 11 persons were arrested from Chandina centre while supplying copies and six police, two each in Barura, Laksam and Hathazari centres, were injured in stray incidents around the examination centres.

Our Staff Correspondent adds: Four invigilators were expelled from Faridpur and two each from Gopalganj and Kishoreganj, according to official sources.

Meanwhile, at least 35 persons, including 15 policemen were injured

in a violence at Hathazari examination centre in Chittagong.

A total of 354 candidates were expelled from Mymensingh while 208 from Tangail. Examinations of two Bangla papers were held on the day.

There was no report of any untoward incident in Dhaka city. There was also no report of any expulsion from any centre in the city on the day. One official source while talking to this correspondent said examinations were held quite peacefully in the city.

The picture of expulsion in Madaripur, Netrakona, Shariatpur and Manikganj was not available. The total number of expulsion from Gopalganj was 189 while expulsion in Jamalpur was 139. A total of 139 were expelled from Sherpur while three from city outskirt Dhamrai.

The number of expulsion from Gazipur was 33 while 79 from Narasingdi. A total of 111 candidates were expelled from Rajbari while 59 from
