

72.61 p.c. fail in RB HSC examns

RAJSHAHI, Nov. 15:—The results of the Higher Secondary Certificate Examinations of the Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, Rajshahi, were announced here today, reports BSS.

A total of 66,774 students appeared in the examinations of whom 18,295 came out successful.

The percentage of pass in the combined groups is 27.39, the group-wise percentages of science, commerce and humanities are 37.61, 23.78 and 22.68 respectively.

Of the successful candidates, 1,646 passed in first division, 9,506 in second division and the 7,143 in third division.

In Science Group, A.N.M. Ehtesham Rafique (940), Roll-28349 of Charmichael College, Rangpur, topped the merit list while the second

and third places were secured by A.S.M. Maksudul Alam (923), Roll-3818 of Rajshahi Cadet College and S.M. Asadullah Ghalib (916), Roll-59177 of Pabna Cadet College respectively.

Rashed Mahmud (814), Roll-983 of Rajshahi University School stood first in the humanities group and Mohammad Khademul Islam (774), Roll-265 of Rajshahi College and Sejana Tahmid (767), Roll-M 14996 of Dinajpur Government College secured second and third positions respectively.

In the Commerce Group, A.K.M. Tarek (712), Roll-751 of Rajshahi College topped the list. The second and third positions were secured by Musrat Jahan (694), Roll-M 58045 of Government Edward College of Pabna.
