SSC exams result

63.05 pc pass in DB, 58.79 pc in JB

Results of the Secondary School Certificate examinations of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education boards of Dhaka and Jessore were announced on Thursday. The percentage of pass in Dhaka Board was 63.05 and that of in Jessore Board was 58.79.

A total of 1,68,122 candidates appeared at the SSC examinations from Dhaka Board of which 1,05,997 came out successful with 54,744 placed in the First Division, 40856 in the Second Division and 10397 in the Third Division.

Omar Sirajul Hassan of St. Joesph High School Dhaka, topped the com-

bined merit of Dhaka Board securing 922 marks with letters in seven subjects.

In Jessore board a total of 1,04,439 examinees appeared at the SSC examinations of which 61,408 came out successful with 26,076 obtaining First Division, 27,299 Second Division and 8,041 Third Division. Mr. Mahmudur Rahman of Jhenidah Cadet College, topped the combined merit list securing 917 marks with seven letters.

Farah Farzana of Vikarunesa Noon School stood first among the female candidates and seventh in the combined merit list of Dhaka Board.

She obtained letters in seven subjects. Tabassum Samad Chowdhury of the same school stood first in the Social Science group securing 866 marks with letters in six subjects.

Afroza Rahman of Cantonment Public School, Jahanabad Cantonment, Khulan stood first among the female candidates and 11th in the combined merit list of Jessore Board securing 887 marks with letters in seven subjects.

Mohammed Anwar Hossain of Dhamura High School, Barisal stood first in the merit list of Social Science group of Jessore Board securing 850 marks with seven letters.
