

HSC exams begin 504 expelled

Over five hundred examinees were expelled on the first day of the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examination through out the country on charge of adopting unfair means in the examination halls on Thursday.

According to the preliminary information, a total of 504 examinees were expelled on the first day of the examination.

Of the total expelled, 175 examinees were expelled under Comilla Board, 131 expelled under Dhaka Board, 185 examinees expelled under Rajshahi Board and 34 examinees expelled under Jessore Board.
