Sircar explains exam system to school teachers

Education Minister Barrister Jamirudgjin Sircar on Tuesday had a meeting with the headmasters and headmistresses of different government and non-government secondary schools to explain the attitude of the government towards recent discontent and tension among the SSC examinees that arose out of different rumours on the system of the SSC examination, reports BSS.

Education Secretary Shafiu1 Alam, Director General of Secondary and Higher Education Prof Eunus Mia and other concerned high officials were present.

The headmasters and headmistresses termed the government decision as wise and timely and opined that this decision was necessary for removing the loopholes of the system and maintaining an appropriate standard of education. They assured the Minister of extending all sorts of help and co-operation in this regard.

They said the common students have no relation with the recent agitations and a group of so-called students are giving incitement to this movement.
