### 2036 HSC examinees expelled on 4th day

More than 2036 HSC examinees were expelled from different centres for adopting unfair means across the country on the fourth day of the examination on Tuesday.

The English Second Paper examination was held peacefully excepting a stray incident at Hulain Salehin College at Potia of Chittagong.

The Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examination under the country's four education boards-Dhaka, Rajshahi, Comilla and Jessore began on Thursday last.

The highest number of 827 examinees were expelled from different centres of Rajshahi board followed by Dhaka 582, Comilla 492 and Jessore 101.

Our Chittagong Office informed: some 393 examinees of Hulain Salehin College centre at Potia under Comilla Board came out of the examination centre and pelted stones at the police when they opposed to adopt unfair means by Deputy Commissioner.

The examinees staged a demonstration at the College premises.
