20 HSC examinees hurt at Tejgaon College centre

At least 20 HSC examinees were injured, one of them seriously, following a clash between the examinees and the students and employees of Tejgaon College on Thursday.

The clash ensued during the Statistics examination when an invigilator seized the answer-sheet of an examinee and drove him out from examination room on charge of adopting unfair means.

According to the sources, other examinees of the centre became agitated when the invigilator drove out the said examinee from the room.

The examinees, came out from the examination hall in a body and tried to stage demonstration in front of the office of Principal.

At this stage, a group of em-

ployees of the College chased the examinees with sticks and then both groups locked in clash. On receipt of information, students of nearby hostel of Tejgaon College rushed to the spot and also attacked the examinees.

The examinees, at this stage, took shelter in a house near the college. Students and employees gheraoed the house and beat the examinees and damaged the furniture of the house, witnesses said.

Azad Hossain Patwari, an examinee received serious injury during the incident and he was later admitted to a city clinic.

After an hour-long trouble, the examinees left the area with the cooperation of the local people.

Police rushed to the spot and brought the situation under control.

After the incident most of the examinees are feeling insecure to appear their next examination scheduled to be held at the same centre on Saturday.
