

4453 expelled for cheating in SSC Exam. under Rajshahi Board

RAJSHAHI, May 18:—A total of 4,453 examinees were expelled for adopting unfair means in the examination halls from 158 centres during the SSC Examinations this year under the Rajshahi Education Board according to board control room.

The districtwise break-up of expulsions:

Rajshahi-103; Natore-60; Chapainawabgonj-71; Naogaon-135; Pabna-138; Sirajganj-274; Bogra-221; Joypurhat-67; Lalmonirhat-83; Gaibandha-887; Kurigram-234; Rangpur-363; Nilphamary-88; Dinajpur-721; Panchanga-83 and Thakurgaon-134.

It may be mentioned here that a total of 1,54,318 examinees including 52,274 females from 2,735 schools appeared in the examinations this year.
