

BCS end body resents circular on HSC exams

A meeting of B.C.S. general education association in an emergency meeting at Dhaka T.T. College on June 5 last, resented the circular issued by the Secretary of the Ministry of Education on May 11 last with regard to the holding of ensuing Higher Secondary Certificate (H.S.C.) examinations smoothly.

Presided over by Principal Lutfar Rahman Miah, the meeting observed that the change of examination invigilation system such as invigilation by the teachers from one college to another college would not be materialised.

The meeting resolved that instead of introducing triangular arrangement, strong vigilance team should be formed. The meeting also resolved that bodies of the candidate should be searched before entering the examination halls in presence of a magistrate and activities of the students' unions should also be suspended.

The meeting further resolved that the student leaders and magistrates should not be allowed to enter the examination halls and Section 144 should also be promulgated in and around the examination centres.
