JCD, police clash in DU

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal activists locked in a clash with police at Dhaka University on Tuesday night, while protesting the bomb attack at a meeting venue in Chittagong, reports UNB.

Witnesses said the JCD members became angry when police intercepted their protest procession in front of the University Central Mosque at about 8:30 p.m.

Police lobbed tear gas shells, some of those in residential halls, and resorted to baton charge to disperse the workers of JCD, the student wing of main opposition BNP.

In retaliation, the JCD members blasted a series of crude bombs and damaged more than a dozen vehicles at the TSC and adjoining areas.

Later, they held a meeting in front of the Surya Sen Hall. It was addressed by JCD president Shahiduddin Chowdhury Annie and general secretary Habibunnabi Sohel.

The JCD will also hold a protest rally on the university campus today (Wednesday) morning.
