

10 injured as BCL-JCD clash at RU hall

RAJSHAHI, Dec. 30:— At least 10 students were injured in a clash that occurred between the activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) and Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) at Nawab Abdul Latif Hall of Rajshahi University last night.

Campus sources said, the clash ensued following capturing of a seat of the hall last night. The hall authority had allocated a seat in Room no-228 to a student belonging to BCL. The seat was occupied by an activist of JCD for long time. When the BCL worker went to take his seat last night the JCD workers resisted him that led to a chase and counter-chase between them which created panic among the general students.

Under this situation the provost of the hall convened a meeting the workers of the rival student organisations. According to the decision of the meeting the room was closed with seal and wax.

Tense situation has been prevailing at the hall area following the incident.
