

Bogra Zila School students protest assault on teachers

BOGRA, Apr. 5:—The students of Bogra Zila School staged a violent demonstration in the town in protest against the assault on one of their teachers by a guardian on Saturday, reports APB.

School sources said the guardian of a student, identified as Jahedur Rahman, roughed up teacher Abdur Rashid in school premises during an altercation over a trifling matter.

Following the incident, teachers of the school detained Jahedur Rahman, who reportedly belongs to the ruling Awami League, in an office room.

The enraged school students brought out a procession in the town in protest against the incident.

They also put up road barricade in the town's Satmatha Crossing disrupting traffic for about an hour. Several autorickshaws, rickshaws and nearby shops were also damaged by the unruly protesters.

Later, the siege was withdrawn when the guardian begged apology from the teacher in public for his misdeed at the mediation by local administration.

Another report says: One person was stabbed and killed Friday night on the outskirts of the town, police said.

The victim was identified as Sribas Mohanta, 50, an employee of Gabtali Thana Health Complex in the district.

Police said some assailants stabbed him at Jamirtala in Sadar thana at about 10 pm on Friday. Local people rushed him to Mohammad Ali Hospital where he expired at 2 am.

A case was filed with the Sadar police.
