

## Concern over DU campus violence

Education Minister ASHK Sadique on Monday expressed his deep concern over the creation of panic on the Dhaka University campus by the armed-outsiders, reports BSS.

In a statement, the minister said, "a vested quarter is trying again to disrupt the existing congenial atmosphere of the educational institution".

Quoting some news items published on Monday in different newspapers, he said, "activists of a certain student organisations coming from outside in a micro-bus" are imposing terrorism on Dhaka University campus.

Mr Sadique said a congenial atmosphere is prevailing now in the educational institutions. "The present government has rooted out terrorism, which was patronised in the past at the state level, the minister added.

He said that law and order has now improved a lot, as the government did not give shelter to any terrorist.

He urged all concerned to maintain the prevailing peaceful atmosphere at the campuses and urged the students, teachers and guardians to resist the terrorists. He said "terrorists would be compelled to yield to the public opinion against them".
