Rajendra College office rooms ransacked by dacoits

FARIDPUR Mar 20 : The office rooms situated at the original campus of Government Rajendra College were ransacked by a gang of dacoits on the night following March 11.

According to college sources, the dacoits numbering 10 to 15, equipped with fire arms tied up the night guard, broke into the office rooms, unlocked 17 heavy almirahs and iron safes, but found no cash or valuables. They searched in vain each drawer, as the money was deposited with the bank earlier.

On receipt of information, Principal of the college Prof Subhash Chandra Ghosh and high police officials visited the spot. No missing or damage to any important paper, was reported.

Some armed dacoities and violence committed in the town in a couple of weeks bear testimony to the fact that there are huge illegal arms in hands of miscreants harboured by godfathers. The town dwellers are extremely terror-stricken now.
