Khawaja Pir Zamin Nizami, Syed Bokhari, Sajjadnashin (head priest) of Dargah of Hazrat Khawaja Nizamuddin Aulia Delhi said on Saturday that he has come to Bangladesh with a message of blessings for progress, prosperity, happiness and Unity of all Muslims.
