DPRK will collaborate in education field

Bangladesh and the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK) have decided to further collaborate in the fields of basic (primary) education and the development of vocational and technical education, says BSS.

The visiting DPRK Chairman on Educational Commission Mr. Choi Tae Bok and Education Minister Dr. A. Majeed Khan during their formal talks Wednesday, discussed the progress of cultural agreement between the two countries and means of expanding cooperation in the field of education and culture.
