turers Association (BEMA) before the recently concluded session of the ninth general assembly of AEU in Tokyo.

A BEMA Press release issued in Dhaka on Wednesday said that the association's proposals to promote sub-contracting from developed to developing countries short courses in developing countries and the exchange of video training materials were also approved by the general assembly.

A five-member committee, including Bangladesh, was formed by the AEU's general assembly to implement in phases the five-point BEMA proposals.

The BEMA submitted the proposals to the AEU to ensure the transfer of electronics manufacturing technology. A five-member BEMA team, led by its Chairman Mr Md. Shamsul Islam, attended the Tokyo meeting.
