



ECNEC approves Tk 11.32 crore project for CU

The Executive Committee of the National Economic Council (ECNEC) approved one project with an investment expenditure of Taka 11 crore 32 lakh including a foreign exchange component of over Taka one crore, reports BSS.

The approval was given at of the ECNEC held on Tuesday at the cabinet room of Bangladesh Secretariat with Prime Minister Moudud Ahmed, in the chair, says an official handout.

Major General (Retd) Mahmudul Hassan, Minister for Agriculture, A.K.M. Mayeedul Islam, Minister for Jute, Air Vice Marshal (retd) A.K. Khandker, Minister for Planning, Sardar Amjad Hossain, Minister for Fisheries and Livestock, A.B.M. Golam Mostafa, Minister for Energy and Mineral Resources, Dr. Wahidul Haque, Minister for Finance and senior officials of concerned ministries and divisions and the planning commission were present at the meeting.

The approved project related to the ministry of education is further development of Chittagong University under the third Five Year Plan. The project envisages provision of minimum essential academic and residential facilities to students, teachers and other staff for smooth functioning of the university. The main work of the project includes enhancement of students enrolment from 5000 to 6000 by 1990, construction of 30 unit quarters for teachers and officials and construction of infrastructural facilities like gas line, electricity and water supply.
